Open Source Software Developer Report 2024

96% of developers who responded to the survey are **involved with open source software**.



88% agree that open source allows organizations to innovate faster.





Almost all respondents (99%) believe that **learning new skills** is an important strategy for career growth.



96% of respondents reported that staying up to date with fast-paced changes to technologies is important.

Meetups and SIGs are considered important for career growth by 63% of respondents.



The #1 objective at Open Source Summits and conferences is connecting with other IT developers.





82% of respondents believe **Open Source Summits and conferences** are important for career development. More than half of respondents (52%) say that the importance of Open Source Summits and conferences has increased in the last 3 years.





The most significant value from attending professional events is finding inspiration and motivation.



59% of respondents perceive value in keeping up with open source ecosystems by **attending professional events**.

The most-attended open source events are KubeCon/CloudNativeCon (40%), Open Source Summits (27%), and PyCon (15%).
